After this lesson, the student should be able to develop treatment plans and strategies for the orthopedic patient, chart treatments that comply with various insurance coverages, understand the clinical process of ARTS (asymmetry, ROM assessments, tissue texture variations and special tests) and apply muscle energy technique (MET), myofascial release (MFR), joint mobilizations and lymphatic balancing to treat individuals who are dealing with acute and/or chronic injuries. Treatment applications will be global and techniques will be applied depending on the condition of the patient (acute vs. chronic).
