

Scraping Therapy (Gua Sha)

Course Description:

Scraping therapy is a form of manual therapy on soft tissues where a small tool is used to gently scrape over soft tissue (fascia, ligaments, tendons, and muscles). This aids in breaking down scar tissue that results from trauma or overuse. Scraping therapy also helps promote a better healing environment by improving circulation in the acute area. Some advantages of scraping therapy include pain relief, decrease in overall treatment/ recovery time, and a reduced need for anti-inflammatory medication.

Time Allotment: 10 hours Prerequisites: 150 hours basic massage training Instructor: Peter Shin

Lesson Objective

After this lesson the student should be able to

- 1. Have an understanding of scraping tools and its benefits.
- 2. Demonstrate the proper use of scraping tools including sanitation and preparation
- 3. Demonstrate assessment and treatment plans

INSTRUCTIONAL METHODS: Lecture, demonstrations and practical assessments will be used in this course. The students time during this course is allocated among a set of interrelated activities, including lecture and classroom discussions, group preparation of in class assignments. Students will be required to provide models when needed.
